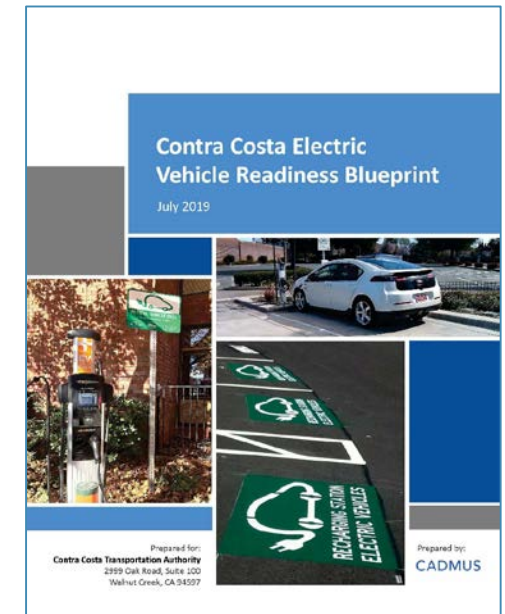
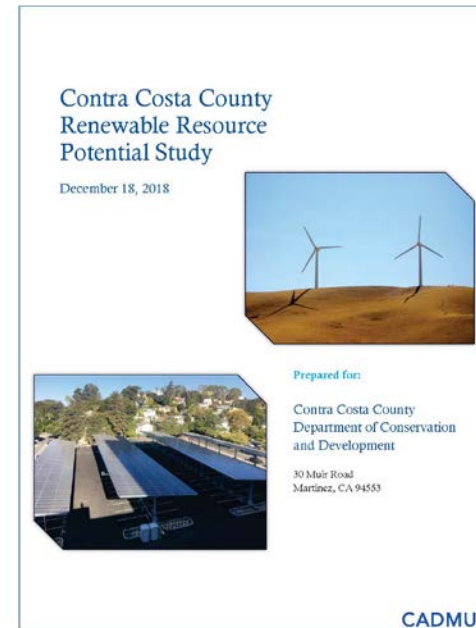

Funding Example: Oakland Unified School District

Living Schoolyards and Climate Literacy

- School Board in February 2019 adopted policies calling for master plan for living schoolyards and incorporating climate literacy into environmental education policy
- Living Schoolyards Partners:
 - Trust for Public Land
 - \$566,000 – State Coastal Conservancy Prop 1 Grant (Nov 2017)
 - \$1,186,977 – CA Natural Resources Urban Greening Grant (Oct 2018)
 - \$500,000 – State Coastal Conservancy Climate Ready Grant awarded (Feb 2019)
 - Additional support from Kaiser Permanente Northern California and Hellman Foundation
 - Rose Foundation - \$470,000 CA Natural Resources Urban Greening Grant
